#### What has been happening this week?

This week we welcomed many parents who are starting the process of applying for Reception places for September 2025. #### **Census Day - We Need Your Help!**

On Thursday 3rd October it is Census Day - **this is a very important day for our school**. The money that the government gives our school, is dependent on how many children are in school on this day, and this day alone. Therefore, it is really important to us that every child is in school on Thursday, and that they are not late. The money the government gives us goes towards us being able to maintain and run a safe, effective and well-resourced school.

#### Safety in the Area

As you we are sure you know, there have been a number of upsetting and frightening incidents in the local area involving thefts, muggings and intimidation. Only recently a Year 7 boy was chased and threatened by some youths with a weapon.

If your child is in Year 5 or 6 and they walk home alone, please can we encourage you to reinforce with your child about ways to keep themselves safe:

- Keep mobile phones hidden
- Travel with a friend if possible
- Go straight home and not to the park or shop
- Avoid groups and engaging with strangers
- Go to a safe place such as school or Found Hope, if they are worried.

#### **Reading Volunteers**

Learning to read is a crucial part of a child's education and being given the opportunity to read to different people, helps them to grow in confidence, stamina and fluency.
